

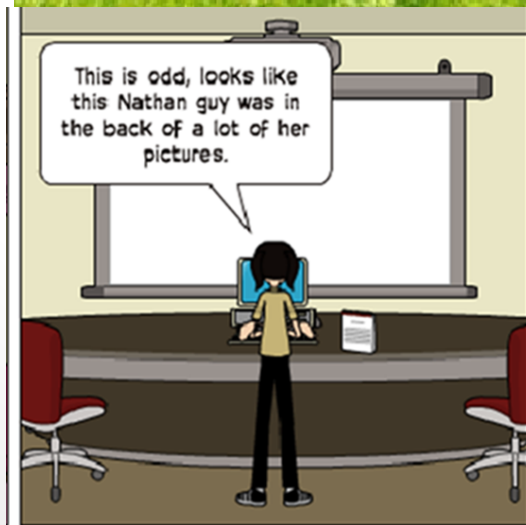




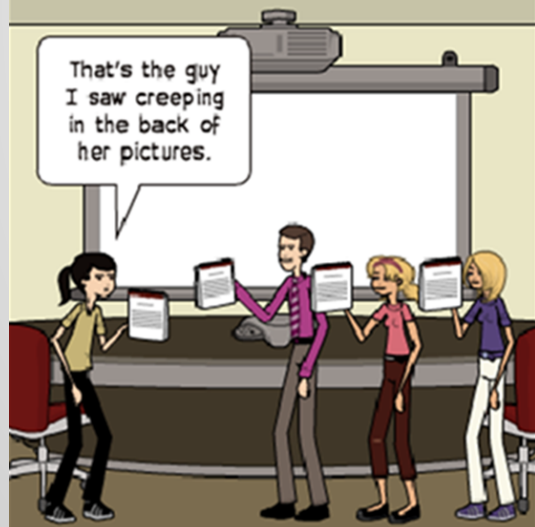
Step 3: Decide on a plan of action.
