



How To SEW ON A BUTTON!



You need good quality thread...



...you need good quality needles,
in a size that you like.



Thread your needle...




Pull about 12 inches
through the eye
of the needle.

Fold over the thread
so that you have
two tails.



Cut your thread.

Cartoonize



Tie a knot by looping the tails together, twice.

Cut the extra tail off below the knot


Insert the needle coming up from the back side of the garment.

Push the needle up and down through the first pair of holes...

...three times.

Side note: If it is a 2 holed button, do a total of six passes.



Come up under the button, not through the holes.



Wrap the thread between the button the button and fabric three times.




Take one stitch on the back; pull the thread through; form a loop.



Create a new loop as you pull it tight.



Do this twice. On the third time, pull the thread through completely.



Put the needle through the fabric
and come up a $\frac{1}{4}$ of an inch away...
