






PROHIBITION

ILLEGAL ACTIVITY BOOMED DURING THIS TIME. BIG BUSINESS STARTED IN THE PRODUCTION OF ALCOHOL AND GANG ACTIVITY SOARED. THE 18TH AMENDMENT LED TO THE CREATION OF SECRET BARS CALLED "SPEAKEASIES" WHERE ALCOHOL WAS SERVED ILLEGALLY.

PROHIBITION ENDS AT LAST!





TARIFFS WERE ESSENTIALLY TAXES ON GOODS.






LIKE I SAID BEFORE, I FOUND MYSELF IN THE POCKETS OF THOSE WHO REALLY APPRECIATED ME.




ISOLATIONISM CAME TO AN END WHEN 60 COUNTRIES SIGNED THE KELLOGG-BRIAND PACT.



KELLOGG-BRIAND PACT IS AN AGREEMENT, PROMISED TO REDUCE THE NUMBER OF MILITARY WEAPONS EACH COUNTRY HAD.



STUDY POINT



LIFE DID IMPROVE DURING THIS TIME, PEOPLE PROSPERED AND MADE ENOUGH MONEY TO ENJOY NEW TECHNOLOGIES, LIKE THE AUTOMOBILE. HOWEVER, SOME PEOPLE HAD HARD LIVES DURING THIS TIME. THE GOVERNMENT LEARNED THEY CAN'T CONTROL EVERYTHING AND HAD TO ACT AS DEMOCRATIC ALLIANCE.
